Answers to Questions received as at November 29, 2022

- Q1: For work samples, is it permissible to provide a link in the proposal document to a cloud folder containing uncompressed PDF files?
- A1: It is acceptable to provide a link for work samples but please ensure that the files are downloadable and/or the link does not expire to allow for access for the duration of the RFQ.
- Q2: Can companies from outside Vancouver, British Columbia, Canada submit to this RFQ?
- A2: Yes, the submissions are not limited geographically.
- Q3: Are vendors required to appear in person for meetings?
- A3: No, meetings can be held over conference call or online meeting platform.
- Q4: Can vendors perform the tasks related to the RFQ outside of Canada?
- A4: This would be specific project requirement dependent.
- Q5: Can we submit proposals via email?
- A5: Per RFQ section 3.1, yes, email submission is required.
- Q6: In Section 4.6, Desirable Evaluation Criteria, item 2 asks for project examples that demonstrate experience directly related to the BC forest sector. How important is it that our project examples are related to the BC forest sector? We have extensive experience providing services requested in a broad range of sectors, including construction and sustainability, but haven't done much work in the forest sector.
- A6: The experience directly related to the BC forest sector is not mandatory. Please refer to Section 2.2.2 for other desirable areas of experience, which are:
 - Forest industry including wood product manufacturing
 - Architecture and design
 - Wood construction including green building innovation and trends
 - Forest management and/or sustainability



- Q7: In Section 2.2.2, the document lists seven service categories. Can you expand on what the "creative" service category includes? What services or deliverables would be included in this category?
- A6: This is a typo. See section update below.
